Race Distances:	250m, 500m, 4000m
Regatta Course:	7 racing lanes, width 13,5m Electronic time measurement / target video Starting pontoons in front of the starting line
Racing Classes:	Mixed, Sport Basic and Sport Premium
Crew Requirements:	At least 8 female paddlers Classification according to time runs into corresponding classes
Competition mode:	1st Race is set as qualification race for all crews. First 21 by time are set to Sport Premium, 22 to 42 by time are performing the Sport Basic Competition. The respective competition will then be held and honoured separately.
Dragonboats:	European Standard 10-Bank Dragonboat Dragonboats will be provided for the event.
Regatta Fee:	350,00 Euro per team (250m and 500m guaranteed, 4000m optional according special regulations (see below)) 26 wristband included
Payment Deadline:	6 weeks after confirmation of a starting place

Safety instructions and conditions of participation

Dragonboat Festival Hannover 2020

Sport-Teams site 1/3

1. Only teams that have sent their binding and proper registration by 01.03.2020 and paid the entry fee on time are eligible to participate.
2. All participants take part in the event at their own risk.
3. Each participant must be able to swim 300 meters in the clothes he wears in the boat during the races. Additionally, every participant must be in good health and physical condition too.
4. The person who registers the team for the regatta is responsible to inform each participant about the conditions of participation and safety instructions before the event and to point out their content and significance sufficiently.
5. Deposit fee of 100,00 Euro for the long distance race: pre-registration starting 01.12.2019 online. The preliminary order will be done according to the receipt of registration. The payment of the deposit on 29th March 2019 guarantees the start in long distance competition.
6. A team that has been promoted from the Fun-Sport competition to the Sport class competition and is not able to get a result better than the last five ranks of the Sport-Basic competition for the following two years can afterwards apply again to start in the Fun classes.
7. Each team has to nominate a team captain and a deputy team captain, both are the contact persons for the organisational staff from the time of registration until the end of the regatta. At least one responsible person must take part in the team captain meetings. Participation is mandatory!

In justified cases, the organisation team may allow exceptions to the mandatory participation in team captain meetings at the written request of the team captain.

The team captain and his/her deputy are responsible for the safety and behaviour of the team on land and water during the regatta.
8. The team captains meeting will take place on Friday, 29th May 2020, at 06:00 pm. The location will be announced soon.
9. For the participation of persons under 18 years old a declaration of consent signed by a legal guardian is mandatory and must be presented by the team captain upon request.
10. The instructions of the organisation personnel as well as their representatives must be followed unconditionally and without restriction for the own safety of the team captain.
11. The organizer, the sponsors, the volunteers, officials and persons entrusted with the organization of the event will be released from any liability with the sending of the binding registration.
The organizer accepts no liability for lost or damaged clothing and equipment of the participants.
12. There is a duty to inform by the participants. Updates regarding the group division, the race schedule and the starting times of the teams can be found on the website www.drachenbootfestival-hannover.de. The last and final update of the race programme will be announced and distributed at the team captains meeting with the. Updates and current information of the event will also be published on the website.





13. The Hanover Canoe Club of 1921 e. V. (HKC) provides a helm during the regatta if necessary. There is no right to a certain helm. Teams wishing to provide their own helm during the regatta must notify HKC in advance in written form. HKC reserves the right to grant or refuse this request.

14. Boats and paddles are provided by the HKC. This material must be handled with care by the participants. Deliberate or grossly negligent damage must be replaced by the participant.

15. The areas provided by HKC to the teams for self-catering and accommodation will be left by the participants after the event as found. Costs caused by possible damage or contamination will be transferred without exception to the responsible and invoiced to the respective teams by HKC.

16. Teams that use a grill, i.e. an open fire, are obliged to have a fire extinguisher visibly available.

17. Gas-powered grills, appliances, etc. are prohibited.

18. Own power generators are not allowed. Electricity is available at all campsites. This can be used by all participants to the normal extent. The organizer is not responsible if the fuses are triggered due to excessive use or defective equipment. In case of difficulties or problems here, a secure supply of electrical power can not be guaranteed.

19. The participants of the event will receive registration wristbands from the organizer. These must be worn during the entire event and may not be removed. They authorize the holder to use or enter the various venues (marshalling area, evening events, etc.).

20. Each paddler is only allowed to wear one registration wristband. The wristband may only be exchanged by the organizer. Misuse will be punished with a time penalty of 5 seconds in the next race or disqualification of the entire team. A refund of any fee is excluded.

21. 2 paddlers from a "higher" race class per crew are allowed to attend as paddler in a race. Paddlers with a registration tape of a "lower" race class are not allowed to paddle in a crew of a "higher" race class.

22. The crew consists of a minimum of 16 and a maximum of 20 paddlers, a drummer and a helmsman. During the races the boat must include at least 8 female paddlers.

23. The drummer must be at least 14 years old.

24. Teams that do not show up at the start on time will be excluded from the race. A refund of the starting fee is excluded.

25. The protest time is 10 minutes after the announcement of the race result at the regatta office. An objection can be raised against a deposit of 50 Euro, which will be refunded in case of a positive decision. The team captain has to be ready during this time as well as the team for another 20 minutes if a race has to be repeated.

26. The race results and the race schedule will be posted at the regatta office during the event and made available online.

27. The team captains agree that their data may be stored for the use of the event.





28. Right to one's own image. The organiser and third parties commissioned by the organiser are entitled to produce picture, sound and audiovisual recordings of the visitors within the framework of the events without remuneration for the persons depicted and to use them or have them used in any way comprehensively in all known and future media, in particular for reporting in all media including Internet, on sound or audiovisual carriers as well as for advertising the event, for acquiring sponsors and for all other activities of the organiser. All rights may also be transferred to third parties for the aforementioned purposes.

29. The personal data provided during registration will be stored and processed for the purposes of carrying out and processing this and future events and for purposes of media reporting and the commercial sale of event photos & videos. By registration, the participant consents to the storage of data for this purpose. The participant agrees to the disclosure, publication of his name, first name, year of birth, club, start number and results (rankings and times) in all reporting print media (entry result, results list, etc.) and in all electronic media such as the Internet.

By sending the online registration form, I accept points 1 to 29 of the safety instructions and conditions of participation without restriction.

We reserve the right to take further measures (time penalties, disqualification and exclusion from the event) if any of these points are violated. A refund of any fee is excluded.
